- To craft them to come up with the problem statement for their innovation.

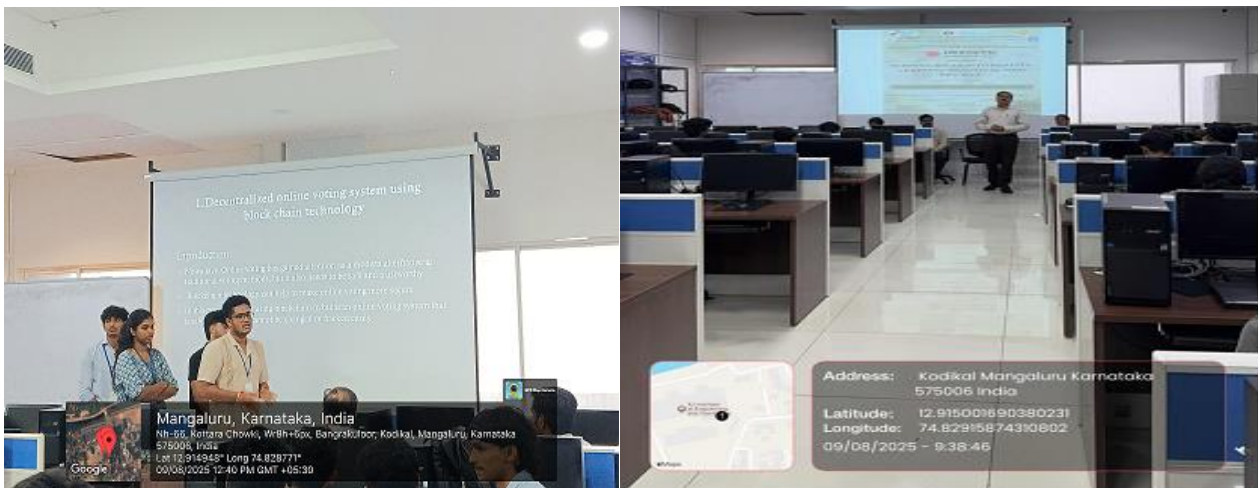
Outcomes: On successful completion of program of this session the student should able to:
